

GARLIC MUSTARD:
HOW DO I IDENTIFY IT?

1. All parts smell like garlic when crushed.
2. Rosettes (below, right) are green as soon as snow melts. Few other plants green up that early.
3. White, four-petaled flowers (below, left) bloom in May and June—again, not much else blooms white that early. Flowering stalks can be from 3” tall in some



shady areas to 3 feet tall in sunny, open areas.

4. Leaves on the flower stalks (left) are triangular and toothed. See our website for color photos!
