

PUBLIC HEARING OF JANUARY 16, 2012 AT 4:00 P.M. FOR A GRANT/LOAN WITH
RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,348 FOR A 2012 4X4 CHEVY TAHOE
FOR THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

The hearing was called to order by Chairman Doucette with the following Commissioners present: Commissioners Mattson, Rondeau, VanLandschoot, and Doucette. Absent ó Commissioner Pullen.

Deputy Brock was present to discuss the rural development grant/loan and the 2012 4x4 Chevy Tahoe. He said that back in August they were talked to by Commissioner Pullen to join MIDeal. They give the lowest priced bids for any equipment. He said that the cost to MIDeal was \$180. He said that they would like to get a vehicle big enough to pull the boat, snowmobiles, and any emergency equipment that they have. This vehicle is fully equipped for the price of \$36,348 including light bars and equipment. \$9,000 is to be paid with federal monies and the rest of the monies are to come from the county in the amount of \$27,348 in the 2013 motor pool budget.

Commissioner Mattson discussed that no monies for this vehicle will come from the 2012 budget.

On a motion by Commissioner VanLandschoot seconded by Commissioner Mattson to adjourn this public hearing. Motion carried by the following vote: Ayes ó Commissioners Mattson, Rondeau, VanLandschoot, and Doucette. Absent ó none.
