

PUBLIC HEARING OF APRIL 11, 2016 AT 4:00 P.M. FOR DISCUSSION ON THE  
ADOPTION OF AN OFF ROAD VEHICLE (ORV) ORDINANCE FOR THE COUNTY OF  
ALGER, MICHIGAN PURSUANT TO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH 2008 PUBLIC  
ACT 240, MCL 324.81131

The hearing was called to order by Chairman Doucette with the following Commissioners present: Commissioners Mattson, Pullen, Rondeau, VanLandschoot, and Doucette. Absent ó none.

Sheriff Hughes explained that there were no changes in the new ORV Ordinance. It is just being renewed with a few more definitions in it. He said that there are a few under Sec. 1; in Sec. 2 no roads are closed; and now a civil infraction is punishable of not more than \$500 fine is Sec. 9 He said that the previous one expired and that there is no expiration date on the new one.

Commissioner Rondeau had some concerns if all roads stay open to ORVs. Sheriff Hughes explained that there is a mechanism to close a road to ORVs due to traffic or narrow roads. He said that the new ORV ordinance mirrors the ordinances of the surrounding counties.

There was no public comment.
