ALGER COUNTY APPORTIONMENT COMMISSION
RESOLUTION

We recommend that the following 5 Commissioner District Plan be approved for Alger County beginning January 1, 2013.

The plan is as follows:

DISTRICT 1: Population— 1,782

District One (1) includes all of Burt Township; that part of Munising Township and the City of Munising running East of Connors Road and South of H-58; and that part of Munising Township South and East of Carmody Road, East of Miners Castle Road North to Lake Superior and North of H-58.

DISTRICT 2: Population — 1,733

District Two (2) includes part of Munising Township running North of H-58 and Carmody Road and West of Miners Castle Road North to Lake Superior; that part of Munising Township West of Connors Road and FFH 13; that part of the City of Munising lying West of Connors Road and East of M-28 and everything running North of Onota Street and East of Elm Avenue running directly North to Lake Superior.

DISTRICT 3: Population: - 1,723

District Three (3) includes all of Grand Island Township; that part of AuTrain Township lying North of M-28 and East of the AuTrain River; and that part of the City of Munising running from the West Line of M-28, South of Onota Street up to Elm Avenue, and everything West of Elm Avenue to the city limits line and running directly North to Lake Superior.

DISTRICT 4: Population — 1,717

District Four (4) includes all of Mathias Township; all of AuTrain Township except that part lying North of M-28 and East of the AuTrain River; and that part of Limestone Township lying East of Coaster Road extended North to Traunik Kiva Road and that part East of the ET Road North to Rock River Township.

DISTRICT 5: Population — 1,799

District Five (5) includes all of Onota Township; all of Rock River Township; and that part of Limestone Township lying West of the ET Road and North of the Traunik Kiva Road and West of Coaster Road extended North and South of said township.

The total population of 8,754 divided by five (5) commissioner districts leaves an average of 1,750.8 per district and the maximum difference is 82. The Range of Deviation is 4.68% with the low at 1.93% and the high at 2.75%.
